Tailor-made seasonal experiences bring Lapland’s nature to life, from amazing Northern Lights excursions to peaceful hikes and canoe trips under the Midnight Sun.

Arcora’s facilities include:

- 42 boutique hotel suites and 20 sky and deluxe villas, with a total capacity of 250 guests
- Two restaurants, an artisan bakery, and a champagne bar
- A wellness world featuring three saunas, cold plunge, outdoor hot tub, rooftop infinity pool, fitness gym, and massage services
- Nature-focused exclusive adventures included in every stay: northern light tours, husky and reindeer safaris, snowmobiling, snowshoeing, hiking, canoeing, and cycling

Despite its remote feel, Arcora is easy to reach – just an hour from Kittilä (KTT) and Enontekiö (ENF) airports, as well as Kolari railway station. Its location on the edge of Finland’s third-largest national park offers rare access to protected landscapes and uninterrupted silence.

Arcora is the newest project by Harriniva Hotels & Safaris, a Lapland-based family business founded in 1973. With Arcora, the company channels over 50 years of experience into a €30 million investment that reimagines sustainable luxury for a new generation of conscious travellers.
